## **Summary of Rulemaking Action:**

To comply with and implement Federally mandated increases to the Cost-of-Living Adjustments (COLA) for recipients of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) program. In addition, an amendment has been made which adds the new qualified non-citizen category to COFA applicants under the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2024 (CAA), Pub. Law 118-42, signed by the President on March 9, 2024. Lastly, language has also been amended at §1.21Replacement of Food Caused by Disaster or Household Misfortune to include verbal notification of a loss of food destroyed in a disaster per FNS regulation.

The Agency does not expect this filing to be controversial and therefore, a public hearing will not be held.

### **Additional Information and Public Comments:**

If no formal objection is received on or before September 22, 2024, the Department of Human Services will file the Amendment and the Final Rule will take effect on this date.

# **Regulatory Analysis Summary and Supporting Documentation:**

To meet the needs of individuals and families experiencing food insecurity, benefit amounts and deductions have increased to reflect recent changes in cost of living due to inflation. For SNAP eligibility, COFA citizens are not subject to a waiting period and are immediately eligible for benefits as long as they meet all other SNAP financial and non-financial eligibility requirements.
